8. Echo



Correction: This is false.

According to the World Health Organisation, approximately 0.5–1% of men globally are diagnosed with breast cancer.

Due to its rarity, it is often detected at a late stage, which can be fatal. Men also need to conduct regular breast self-examinations.

Myth #4: "If I don't have a family history of breast cancer, I won't get it."

Correction: This is not true.

People who do not know any family members to have breast cancer have been diagnosed with the disease.

While it is true that having a family member who has had breast cancer is a risk factor, it does not mean those who do not have it are unlikely to have the disease.

Myth #5: Having my spouse suck my breast can prevent breast cancer

Correction: This is false

Breast sucking will only help your spouse notice any abnormalities with your breast and that can motivate you to go for a check-up.

What truly helps in preventing the disease is breastfeeding babies as confirmed by various studies.

Myth#6: Breast cancer is contagious

Correction: This statement is not true

Breast cancer is not a communicable disease, which means it cannot spread from one person to another.

Myth #7: "Breast cancer always appears in the form of a lump"

Correction: This is not entirely true

Some women may experience lumps in their breasts before or during their menstrual cycle, which typically resolves after menstruation. Additionally, some individuals may have breast cancer without noticing any lump in their breasts.

However, if you do detect a lump in your breast, it is important to seek immediate medical attention to confirm that it is not cancerous.

Is Breast Cancer Treatable?

Yes, breast cancer can be treated and it has survival rate when detected early.

Once diagnosed, the treatment approach depends on the cancer subtype and the extent to which it has spread from the breast to other parts of the body or lymph nodes.

To reduce the risk of cancer recurrence, doctors may employ various treatment modalities, including:

- Surgery to remove the breast tumor
- Radiation therapy, which reduces the likelihood of recurrence in the breast and

surrounding tissues

• Medication, such as hormone therapy, chemotherapy, or targeted biological therapies

How Can You Prevent Breast Cancer?

- 1. Quitting and avoiding smoking
- 2. Maintaining a healthy diet
- 3. Limiting alcohol consumption
- 4. Breastfeeding
- 5. Managing your weight
- 6. Regular exercise
- 7. Minimizing exposure to radiation and environmental pollution
- 8. Undergoing an annual mammogram starting at age 50
- 9. Performing a monthly self-breast exam

5 Easy Steps to Carry Out a Monthly Self-Breast Exam

- Before we outline the steps, it's essential to note:
- The purpose of a monthly self-breast exam is not to diagnose breast cancer but to identify any abnormal changes.
- An ideal time to perform a breast self-examination is 2-3 days after the end of your monthly menstrual cycle.
- For women who do not menstruate and for men, choose a specific day every month and adhere to it.



Step 1

Begin by looking at your breast in the mirror with your shoulders straight and your hands on your hips, and check for the following:

- Shape: Normally, one breast is larger than the other, but if you notice a sudden and irregular change, you should be concerned.
- Skin: Look out for an orange peel texture. Dimpling, puckering, redness, and rashes should also be checked for.
- Nipples: Check for itching, scaliness, swelling, or discharge.
- A marble-like lump below the skin.



Step 2

- Lie down and roll onto your left side, placing a pillow under your shoulder or back to examine your right breast.
- Place your right hand on your head/forehead.

Step 3



- •Use the three middle fingers of your left hand and start moving them in small circles.
- •Vary the pressure with each circle.
- •Repeat this for the entire breast, including the nipple, without lifting your fingers.
- Squeeze the nipples to check for discharge.



Step 4

Examine your underarm area starting as high as possible in your armpit and runningyour fingers downwards looking for any lump.



• Repeat steps 2, 3, and 4 on the left breast

In 2020, breast cancer accounted for 685,000 deaths worldwide, making it the second most frequent cancer.

Although the exact cause of breast cancer remains unknown, several established risk factors, such as early menarche, delayed menopause, and the use of hormonal birth control, are known to increase the odds of developing the disease.

It is advised that women between the ages of 50 and 74 undergo breast cancer screening with mammography once every two years. The highest chance of recovery is achieved when breast cancer is detected in its early stages before it spreads to other parts of the body.
